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abstract:

Search aims to know the impact of teaching strategies according to the theory of multiple intelligences in the development of written expression skills and achieve the aim of the research was drafted following null hypotheses:

- \emptyset . No statistically significant difference at the level of $(\cdot, \cdot \circ)$ between the mean scores of fourth-graders literary in written expression skills before and after the application of the strategy of multiple intelligences.
- \triangledown . There is a statistically significant difference at the level of $(\cdot, \cdot \circ)$ between the mean scores of the group that is considering a strategy of multiple intelligences and the group that taught the usual way in written expression skills in the post test.

Current search was limited to a sample of fourth-graders literary in the Directorate-General for Education Karbala / middle and high schools daytime only for the academic year $(\triangledown \circ \lor \lor \neg \neg \neg \circ \lor \triangledown)$ for the second semester of teaching speech. Chose a design researcher partial control of his research groups have adopted equal pre and post tests were one pilot and the other officer were selected randomly preparatory Sheikh Ahmed al-Waeli to conduct the experiment, the total members of the research sample (@o) randomly selected students within two divisions. Division (a) represent the experimental group that teaches expression strategies of multiple intelligences and the number of members (%) students and Division (b) represent the control group, which taught expression in the traditional manner and number (%) students, and rewarded the researcher between students groups statistically using test Altaúa (T -test) for independent samples in the variables (chronological age, and scores of Arabic for the half year for the academic year ($\triangledown \circ \lozenge \lozenge$ - $\nabla \cdot \nabla \nabla$), and degrees scanning tool of multiple intelligences and test tribal rule expression), and chi square test (for collecting school for parents) before the experiment did not show

differences statistically significant between the two groups in these variables.

For the purpose of providing a measuring tool for multiple Zkaouat researcher has adopted Mkiesagihza Zkaouat multi prepared by Dr. (Nabil Rafik al $\forall \cdot \cdot \diamond$), which codified the measurement of multiple intelligences among middle school students.

The researcher used appropriate statistical methods that fit the requirements of his research (test Altaúa for two independent samples, and test Zaúa two interrelated samples, and chi square test, and Pearson correlation coefficient). The main findings of this research were to:

- ↑ There is a statistically significant difference between the
 mean scores of literary quarter-graders in written expression
 skills in pre and post tests in favor of the group that is
 considering a strategy of multiple intelligences.
- ⊽ no difference statistically significant between the mean scores of students of the experimental group and the control group in the (written expression skills) in the post-test for students group Altejrebibh.

III: Conclusions

Based on the findings of the study, the researcher concluded the following:

- √ The strategy of multiple intelligences expansion thought the students and develop their mental abilities and active capacity inert and help make the transition from style to another depending on the type of multiple intelligences, and diversity in teaching methods and the use of tools and educational activities appropriate, and this has a significant impact on raising the level of thinking.
- ∇ The use of multiple intelligences strategies in teaching

expression of shares in the development of written expression skills of students.

♥ - that outweigh the strategy of multiple intelligences usual way back to the role of this strategy in highlighting Zkaouat students inert and development active Zkaouathm.

IV: Recommendations

In light of the results of current research and reached conclusions, the researcher recommends the following:

- v. Teaching strategies based on multiple intelligences in teaching fourth grade expression literary, for their positive impact and clear and effective role in raising the level of academic achievement of students.
- ∇. Development and faculty development through practice and training on teaching strategies take into account the multiple intelligences.
- ♥. Diversification of the educational activities in the classroom for one academic integrity commensurate with the multiple intelligences of students, so that every student can benefit from the activity which falls on his wits.
- §. Interest using a variety of teaching activities appropriate to the nature of subjects including topics provides an opportunity for students to use multiple Zkaouathm and creative thinking skills have different
- a. Interest in student activities and diversify because they
 contribute positively to detect all types of intelligences have and
 develop better and evolution which leads to raise the level of
 achievement.

Fifth: the proposals:

Complement the current research suggests researcher conducting research and the following studies:

- ↑ perform a similar search for the current search inspired by
 sex workers and school stage a key variable in the study.
- \triangledown conducting similar research for the current search, but at

different stages and other study materials.

- $\overline{\ }$ experimenting with multiple intelligences with other variables, such as innovative thinking, and learning in order to be able to.
- § perform a similar search for the current research on a sample of students are slow learners.
