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## **Abstract**

### **Accusatives in the Holy Quran**

Praise be to Allah, Pray and peace upon Muhammad, the safe prophet, and upon his gentle descendants and followers. Since I had finished my study in the Master degree, I highly liked to have my study for Doctorate degree in the Holy Quran believing deeply that the Holy Quran is Allah's Miracle Book that straighten the tongue and lighten the hearts with faith. The Holy Quran is the immortal book whose miracles are non-stopped. Besides I believe that this subject contributes in keeping our great Arabic Language safe. Thus, without the Holy Quran, great parts of Arabic Language might be lost like much of other language had been lost.

The motivation of my choice that this subject has more ways and faces for parsing. This subject has a wide meaning in the grammar that it includes under the upraised and above the upper of downed.

I employed the *first chapter* for sentences were accusatives including the saying and the sentence at the grade of hanging and the sentence lied as a second force for ((Dhanna)) and its sisters, and the sentence lied an adverb. And sentence lied as an item for (Kan) and its sisters, and a sentence lied as an item, and the excepted sentence.

The *second chapter* is employed for the accusative semi-sentences the lied an object and adverb and denoting.

At the *third chapter* I studied the accusative relative nouns and demonstrative nouns, pronouns and adverbs in detail.

The *fourth chapter* has included various accusative cases that not underlined like the previous cases. And at the Abstract 1 have written down the most important results in this thesis.
