Ultimately, all this aims to apply a reflective ethical approach. Upon completion of this program, the graduate will be able to work as a lawyer in various fields of society and in all kinds of professional situations that require demonstrating their legal skills.

Lawyers in particular, and legal professionals in general, often work in an adversarial environment, where the interests of their clients are the cornerstone of their success in this profession. Therefore, a lawyer and legal professional must arm themselves with all effective legal tools that enable them to defend their client's interests in courts. At the undergraduate level, the law student does not study merely to pass the final exam but to prepare for the day when their word will be decisive in saving an innocent person from the noose. This is a great responsibility that requires the law student, alongside their studies, to embody ethics and virtues commensurate with this responsibility. There is no greater responsibility than practicing a profession or role considered the highest in all societies and religions.

Studying law in Iraq places a great responsibility on the student, as they study in the country that taught the world the foundations of law and organization. On our land lies the first known law in human history, which makes those who study law in Iraq a role model for all countries, enjoying a unique advantage not available to students in any other country.

General Objectives of Studying the Law Program

1. Discover a dynamic educational and research environment that has significantly contributed to the development of law for more than 4000 years.
2. Benefit from comprehensive and diverse legal education that provides access to legal practice and jobs where legal knowledge is a key asset.
3. Benefit from the knowledge and expertise of a broad teaching staff at all levels of study.

6. Focus priorities on the challenges facing the lawyers of the future.
7. Know basic legal terms, be able to define, comment on, and use them.
8. Have knowledge of legal specializations and their meanings (legal systems in each field, judicial precedents, and scientific evaluations).
9. Understand the general concept of law, basic legal rules, and the theory of legal methodology.
10. Take personal or collective responsibility for solving complex legal problems.
11. Be able to evaluate legal cases separately from the perspective of current law and the required law, with a critical objective.

13. Embody honesty, a mindset of justice, fairness, and ethical values imposed by the lawyer's identity.
14. Have sensitivity to social problems, possess social conscience, and adopt the democratic, secular, and social system of the state.

Specific Objectives of Studying the Law Program

1. Training in courts.
2. Offering morning and evening classes.
3. Study duration of 4 years for the bachelor's stage, not less than 2 years for the master's stage, and not less than 3 years for the doctoral stage.
4. Opportunity to obtain an international study trip.
5. Direct practical experiences with clients or other real-life practical experiences, under appropriate supervision, designed to encourage students to reflect on their experiences, the values, and responsibilities of the legal profession, and to develop their ability to evaluate their performance and level of competence.
6. Student participation in charitable activities and working in small groups through seminars, guided research, small classes, cooperative work, etc.

Grading System and Grade Distribution Information

Success is evaluated based on final exams, remedial exams, other coursework completed during the academic year, as well as the student's personal achievement. The success is assessed according to the following grade scale:

Cumulative GPA:

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Admission Requirements

1. For the Bachelor's Program:
 - The candidate must hold a high school diploma (Baccalaureate) from Iraqi schools recognized by the Iraqi Ministry of Education. The minimum overall average varies each academic year depending on the results of the preparatory studies in Iraq and according to the plan set by the Ministry of Planning and Central Admission.
 - Holders of the International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma.
 - International candidates.
 - Transfer students from other colleges.
 - Transfer students from other universities.

2. For the Master's Program:
- The candidate must meet the approved academic background in our college and undergo academic equivalency procedures.
3. For the Doctoral Program:
- The candidate must meet the academic background requirements in our college and undergo academic equivalency procedures.

If a student has previously studied a course at another university and the course content is similar to the corresponding course in the college's program, the student may be exempted from this course upon approval by the relevant committee in the college.
