Structure: Verb + s/es in third person

 First, we use the Present Simple when something is generally true:

Examples: The sun rises in the east.

People need food.

The sun isn't blue.

Second, We use it in the first and the zero conditionals:

Examples: If it rains, I won't come.

If you heat water to 100 degrees, it boils.

 Third, use is for habits or things that we do regularly. We often use adverbs of frequency in this case:

Examples: She gets up at seven o'clock every day.
