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The important of Arabic sentence is attributed to the fact that it is the basic component of language. Speaker expresses their purposes and needs, and communicate with each other via sentence. We think in sentences, in addition to that searching in sentences almost encompasses all parts of grammar. Thus, i have chosen the theme, thanks to the suggestion of Dr. Naema Raheem Al-Azzawi, to study the sentence as mentioned in the wirings of the modernists.

Since the study of sentence means study of grammar, the dissertation was confined to the most important aspects that show the attitudes of the modernists leaving details. The nature of the study stipulated the division into four chapters, and followed by a conclusion. And then, the references and resources.

The first chapter is devoted to the study of the concept of the sentence for the oldest and modernists as well as the opinions of the modernists. The third chapter studies number of issues in the Arabic sentence in the modern grammatical thinking. The fourth chapter, the issues of sentence compliments, in which i have tackled several of these issues to show the attitudes of modernist towards them.

The study resulted in number of results the important os which are:

- The use of *sentence* has not been mentioned in the conceptual sense in the book attributed to Al-Khaleel B. Ahmed Al-Farahidi (*Al-Jumil fi-al-Nahou*), but they have been heavily used to refer to the meaning.
- The modernist scholar argued that Al-Mubrad was the first to use *sentence* as a grammatical entry.
- However, the researcher agrees that Abu Zachariah al-Fara'a preceded his in that.
- One of the modernists alleged that the Kufiis did not take the term *sentence* from Al-Mubrad Al-Basari.

- It is proved that the Kufiis were the prior to use the *sentence* in the conceptual sense, not otherwise.
- Old grammarians did not limit *sentence*, but few. Instead, they were calling it speech; they did not illustrate the concept of sense of *sentence*.
- Dr. Kamal was unique in the intensity of *sentences*
