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## Abstract

This thesis focused on the use of place vocables in Al-Jawahiri poetry as one of the aspects that help to discover the significance of this field in construction of his poems and the richness of their meanings .

The study consisted of four chapters preceded by an introduction under the title ( an entry to the concept and method )in which we tried to define the concept of the place as it used by the linguists in the past and present time .

In the first chapter I studied the words that refer to the home; I divided it into three parts; the first part focused on the word (al-dar) in Al-Jawahiri poetry ; definite and indefinite , singular and plural and the context that used into it after considering its meaning in the language , and the characters of its letters .In the second part I studied the word (bait) and its contexts .then , in the third part , I studied words belongs to same semantic field like; (qasr , koukh etc.) .

In the second chapter I studied the words that refer to the country into tow parts; in the first part I studied common words like : balad , watan , qutur and dawla and their contexts .In the second part I dealt with specified word like; al-Iraq , Ardhel-Rafidain , and Ardhel-Sawad . then Baghdad , Al-Zawra , Al-Basrah ...

The third chapter focused on the country names . I divided it into tow parts; I covered in the first one the names of Arab countries which he mentioned more than half of them and too many of their cities and villages . In the second part I tracked the foreign countries .

In the fourth chapter I concentrated on the words indicate to the grave into tow parts; first on the word (qabr) and its contexts , second; on the other words belong to the same semantic field like; jadath , rims , dhareeh ...

Then I summarized the thesis findings in the conclusion of the study .
