The civil society organizations have an economic (developmental) role, as well as their service role.

They are proving their efficiency in directing the developmental projects. This role appeared in the developed countries as an efficient partner for the governmental and private sectors.

In addition, they are becoming an important partner for United Nations organizations, and international and regional organizations.

But, this role still a limited and weak role in the developing countries, including Arab countries, though there are some active and efficient organizations in the developmental aspects, in several Arabic countries, such as Egypt, Lebanon, Yemen and Algeria.

These organizations suffered from many political, economic, organizational and transparent obstacles, which lead to restrict their developmental role.

In Iraq, there is no clear role to the civil society organizations in the field of development to undertake their efficient role in society.

These organizations has, yet, no real and efficient role in the developmental path of the society. Their activities characterized as service and cure ones, and the government doesn't recognize them as a third partner in directing the national evelopment. They are suffering organizational, structural, financial and cultural obstacles, which are restricted their role.

To activate their role, there is a need to some mechanisms to raise their contribution, through establishing a civil transparency, encouraging the subjective efforts to support the national development strategies, and eliminating the institutional, structural, legal obstacles, which restrict their role.
