Economic Role of State in the Globalization

Abstract

In the light of inability of nations to include the incremental production capabilities and the capital and commodities movement, a phenomenon of nationalize the economic and productive operations was merged which is called "Globalization" However, the concept of the globalization is still nebulous (mysterious) and the questions are focused on: what is to be globalize and how? What are the changes that the globalization achieved or will be achieved?

The problem of research is to study the globalization and the role of state which is based on its nature and social structure. Thus, such a problem is out of control using the economic theory alone, but the other social scientces must also be used on the ground that there are so many different opinions and various point of views as well as the uncertainty regarding the globalization and the role of state required.

The objective of research is to study the future relationship between the role and economic action of state."In the developing countries on particular" through the new phenomenon of globalization.

The hypothesis of research is that the role of state and its economic action will remain constructive in all economic systems through producing and distributing the economic surplus despite that the role of state must absolutely be reconstructed according to the subjective circumstances imposed by the time stage, economic problems and the balance between the social powers and their economic development stages.

Several points are concluded in the research, among them:-

- 1- The transformation process from eonomic system to another or from Stage to another inside a specific system does not commence on the level of state but on the development of stage a new production system.

- 3- Globalization is coming rapidly, however, that does not mean the end of role of the national state and its functions.

- 6- It is not necessary the conflict between the role of state and the role of the private sector.
